



Canadian Navigable Waters Act

The Nanaimo Airport hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Navigable Waters Registry pursuant to the Canadian Navigable Waters Act for public comment described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 10(1)(b) of the said Act, the Nanaimo Airport has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 10934, a description of the following work, its site and plans:

- PID 005-500-605 – located on the north side of Nanaimo Airport, the installation of 1 pile in the gravel bar of Haslam Creek for the purpose of installing a runway alignment indicator light on top and includes the installation of an electrical power line below ground and below the channel which is to be accomplished by horizontal directional drilling. Work to be conducted outside of bird breeding and fish windows.
